ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE:

- Our school is known for its uniqueness we believe a fun, vibrant, stress free learning environment with a curriculum designed on the basis of **Inquisitive Learning**Students are presented with stimulus resources to spark interest, and then guided with the skills and concepts needed for the inquiry. The students are assessed on the basis of their creative knowledge.
- * Academics for secondary level is done through **Experiential learning** which is the process of **learning** through hands on experience, and is more specifically defined as "**learning** through reflection on doing".
- * **Education Through Music"** an initiative is taken to teach music to children through an integrated approach
- Infinite Engineers: Hands on Science Learning through Dexter Boxes to understand the concept and to love science through fun and play.
- The classroom teaching is carried out successfully through Whole Brain Training (WBT) methodology for Attention Getter, Brain Engager, Direct Instruction, and Collaborative Learning strategies with variation to get 100% engagement from the students.

- * Tech Talk- Computer Science classes are conducted based on the recent needs. Students are given projects based on the latest technology.
- * Vaayu Sastra An Innovative Concept of Human Engineering services started with a motto of developing young talents through Aero Modelling workshops combined with imparting science through theatre arts.
- Math Café-With the basic aim of exploring the power of MATH, to vitalize and invigorate the mathematical skills in learners, encourage them to take baby steps in the world of mathematics and to explore its application in the spheres of Engineering, Architecture, Astronomy, Technology and other disciplines, Students of grade 4 to 9 demonstrated various related projects through Math Café Day which was judged by Mr Nagendran, a senior mathematician.
- * Students at Vedanta joined the Scholastic 'ONE NATION READING TOGETHER' on 24th Nov, 2017 to celebrate the pleasures of reading by taking an oath to make reading as a regular habit.
